

Scholarship Award Program

BAY STATE ARCHERS

The Bay State Archers organization is in the process of developing a scholarship program to assist those young archers who are entering or in the midst of a secondary school education, which will include colleges and universities or a technical school (not vocational high school). We are hoping to have this program up and running by the fall of 2008. Below are some of the particulars and requirements of this program.

PARTICULARS

Scholarship amount will be \$500.00

Can be used as payment for school related expenses - check will be made

Payable to recipient and institution

Scholarship will be awarded in the month of September prior to the start of the semester

Officers and delegates of BSA will determine the winner of the scholarship

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Applicant must be a Bay State Archers Member

Applicant must submit an essay to BSA describing his/her educational Goals and probable use of the scholarship money

Applicant must participate in a minimum of three (3) BSA shoots in the Same calendar year as the request - sign off is required from the BSA delegate at those shoots

Proof of acceptance to an institution will also be required

As previously stated this program is in its very early development stages and changes can be made in the above format. We at Bay State Archers welcome any input to enhance or streamline this program.
